

Growing Through Loss – Support for Those Experiencing Loss in their Lives

Growing Through Loss is a grief and loss support ministry jointly sponsored by the North Suburban Grief Support Coalition, of which 18 churches and organizations in our area are members. The coalition hosts two six-week series each year at various locations that address both the educational as well as support aspects of a variety of loss and grief issues.

The spring series will be held on Monday evenings, April 17—May 22 from 6:45pm—9:00pm, at Abiding Savior Lutheran Church, 8211 Red Oak Dr, Mounds View, MN 55112.

Each session offers an educational presentation by a professional from the community, followed by peer support groups facilitated by leaders who understand the grieving process. Each session is complete in itself, so you may attend any or all sessions. Registration takes place the evening before each session. There is no cost, although donations are welcome. Who: All ages, intergenerational. *Outreach Event*—please invite neighbors, friends, family, etc.

Just come for the day if you want to sleep at home.

When: June 9-11

Location: Rice Creek Chain of Lakes Campground, 7373 Main St, Centerville, MN 55038

Fee: Vehicle Permits—Anoka County required—\$7/day or \$30/year per vehicle entrance. Tent campers no cost! If you want to bring an RV/Motorhome/Camper, please reserve your own site.

What: Come join in an all church camping trip. Play at the beach, enjoy the playground, bring/rent a canoe to use at the boat launch, go fishing or use the hiking trails. Bring your bike if you want to ride the Anoka Bike Trails or your golf clubs to play at nearby Chominox Golf Course. Just come and hang out too if you want a low key relaxing time to sit and talk or read a book. Fun for everyone outdoors. Full schedule will be posted before the trip.

Worship: We will have an evening time around the campfire to discuss highs and lows, sing songs with guitars and pray together.

BWCA Boundary Waters Canoe Trip August 1-6

We have two permits for entry #16 Moose/Portage River North and can take a total of 18 people up to the Boundary Waters on an intergenerational adventure trip!

When: August 1, we will leave in the evening at 6pm and arrive at Grace Lutheran in Ely, MN and spend night in church. We will be on trail 4 full days and then come off water Sunday morning August 6 and arrive home around dinner time.

Who: Intergenerational, all ages welcome, however if under 9th grade an accompanying adult is required.

Cost: \$350 approximate depending on group sizes.

Register: Sign up and put down a \$50 deposit by May 31!

Bring: Full packing list will be coming but you will need your own sleeping bag & pad, canoe pack (rental available), clothes, tent, personal plate/spoon/cup set, and LifeStraw water filter bottle.

Provided: Church will provide (with help of outfitting) Kevlar canoe, paddle, all food and camp kitchen, maps, permits and legal documents, and leadership/canoe guide over a dozen group trips I have guided. We will also provide spirituality content, firs word, bible study, prayer and more.
