#### Dear Siblings in Christ,

This year the season of Epiphany is shorter than usual. Lent is just around the corner! This means mid-week worship begins, Wednesdays at 6:30pm. Soup Suppers at 5:30pm on Wednesdays--and it also means Confirmation students having discussions with their mentors. As a church worker, Lent is \*always\* a busy time. I wonder how often we admit as much. It means extra work: for worship leaders, for volunteers, and even for our property teams, as the building gets a lot more use in these weeks leading up to Easter.



It can be difficult to remember that busyness is not the point of Lent. Returning to the Lord our God is what Lent is about. Turning away from

ourselves and instead turning to God and our neighbor: in gratitude, in servitude, in reflection. As the book of Joel reminds us: "Yet even now, says the Lord, return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning; rend your hearts and not your clothing.

Return to the Lord your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, abounding in steadfast love, and relenting from punishment." -Joel 2:12-13

This Lenten season, let us turn again to God, by connecting with God's Word, attending to our faith practices, and turning to each other in friendship and service. To facilitate this, there will be several **Crossroads Connection Groups** which will be meeting throughout the weeks of Lent (February 14th-March 28th).

These groups will meet weekly for about an hour, depending on the group. The schedule will be available soon and there will be sign up sheets in the narthex at each church. The groups will meet at different times and places throughout the week--and if more than one group sparks your interest, you can participate in more than one group.

Look in the weekly bulletin and in the narthex for more information soon!

This Lent, we will also be exploring **Gratitude** as a weekly topic in worship. If we are to return to God in this season, we also need to attend to our own stewardship of God's gifts. Everything belongs to God, we are merely caretakers of God's abundance.

May these connection groups; our shared meals, and shared worship throughout this season remind us of how richly God has blessed us.



Review of minutes from November 15, 2023 and special budget meeting of December 16, 2023

Special budget meeting updates needed: Motions and second for the proposed budget.

Motion to approve both documents as presented by Peg, seconded by Kolleen, all in favor; motion carried.

**Financial Reports** 

Treasurer's Report

Bank account signers: Jon and Paula are authorized. Each account needs 2 people authorized as signers.

Solidifying the counting process, will be using the same process for both churches

**Team Reports** 

Introduction of Teams for 2024:All of us on council are involved with the work being done around Cross of Glory. We need to foster communication between the council and the different groups.

Keep a pulse on the groups so we know what's going on and what they need.

Matt has asked Dawn for a list of past council presidents. Special project for Kolleen - get a group to brainstorm (especially around finances) what has worked, what didn't work, what they would have done differently, etc. (Past presidents: Kolleen Olsen, Jeff Kinsel, Tim Schmidt, Rob Wilkinson). Matt would like to have the group as an advisory group when he needs advice. Communicating with the Congregation

Paula gets asked "what's going on" more than the rest of us

Paula will pass on the questions to Matt

Council Meetings are open to everyone in the congregation

Gretchen will provide minutes to Dawn for the monthly newsletter.

#### **Old Business**

AED Update: Per Jon (1/24) AED in process of being purchased.

The AED is \$2100. It is able to cover both Adults and Children with a push of a button (no need for additional accessories, unlike other brands). There will be ongoing maintenance for it every couple of years for new pads and batteries at some point. We currently have \$1050.00 that was set aside by donors to go towards an AED. I believe there is another donor waiting in the wings to donate a chunk of the rest, but I will look into that and confirm.

Jon will write documentation on AED info; how to unlock the bathrooms; tornado preparedness (Sunday school office or hallways around the fellowship hall.)

Jon ordered cases for the credit card readers; and would like to order a box of 500 printable checks. Authorization is not required, Jon will log it under office supplies.

Church space vs. cost of rental

Relative costs for area (similar properties vs. amenities)

Consistent approach

Need to look at our space and determine what are the rates for rooms within the church. This will also help us to update our terms with New Birth Church.

Jumbo Sale uses a lot of the church space in June, July, and August.

#### **New Business**

Appointment of Treasurer for 2024 fiscal year.

Gretchen motions to appoint Jon, Peg seconded ;all in favor; motion passed

Council acknowledges the housing declarations from Pastor Cassie and Deacon Brad have been received, and the treasurer will process the appropriate paperwork.

Nomination of Youth Representative for 2024.

The voting membership of the Congregation Council shall consist of the pastor(s), the deacon(s), and not more than 9 nor fewer than 6 members of this congregation, at least one of whom shall be a youth and at least one of whom shall be a young adult.

Council has 8 members currently. Claire has been elected for a 3 year term. Should we use the 9th spot to appoint a youth representative (unclear if this would be a voice with or without a vote?) Potential candidates: Bea Kaden, Brianna Thomalla, Eli Nault, Owen VanErt.

Paula motions to ask the 4 candidates if they are interested in a 1 year term on council. Claire seconded. Claire will reach out to the candidates. All in favor; none opposed; motion carries

#### Election of officers for council

Gretchen - Secretary

Kolleen: Motion to fill position for secretary by Gretchen, Peg as Vice president; Paula seconded. All in favor; non opposed; Motion carries

Paula would like to use some of the donated money to get the carpets professionally cleaned. Paula will talk with Kevin and get a proposal for the work.

Matt to grant permissions to the google docs for all council members

Next meeting: Feb 21 at Atonement 6:30 (Kolleen will be absent). Send reports/updates to Matt at least 7 days prior to the meeting.

Gretchen to pull out to-do items with who is responsible.

Old business needs to have due dates so that the old business doesn't stay on the list forever.
