

Therefore, as God's choice, holy and loved, put on compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Be tolerant with each other and, if someone has a complaint against anyone, forgive each other. As the Lord forgave you, so also forgive each other. ¹⁴ And over all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.

Dear Siblings in Christ,

As I taught you in worship the week after Easter, the **Confession & Forgiveness** is omitted from the worship service for the entire season of



Easter: yes, Easter lasts SEVEN Sundays! Much like Christmas cannot be contained in one day--it takes twelve--Easter lasts FIFTY days, which lead up to the day of Pentecost. While Lent was a season of preparation, Easter is a season of celebration. So, to celebrate, we observe a Thanksgiving for Baptism or a Call to Worship each week in place of the Confession & Forgiveness.

Each year when we make this shift, at least one person will comment that they miss the Confession because it is so important to their individual faith. I get it. I miss it too for those 7 Sundays. Interestingly, the act of Confession & Forgiveness is an act of **corporate confession**, that is, it is designed to bring the congregation into focus: **worship is not about us but about the living God**. Confession brings us humbly before the Lord and one another, seeing ourselves as we are, as we express our dependence upon the grace of God in the cross of Christ.

As is true for so many things in our current culture, we have unknowingly shifted our Confession & Forgiveness focus toward the individual instead of on us as a community. What's more, the language we often use for Confession & Forgiveness excludes people who are not familiar with this pattern of worship. Do people understand why we do it? Do we understand? That we are handing over any brokenness to God and celebrating that God loves us so much--showing us grace and mercy through it all? Taking it a step further, do we show that grace and mercy to our neighbor? Knowing that we are bathed in God's grace, where do we see the bright light of that grace in our life together?

I have been seeing that light in the work of God's Holy Spirit moving among us. Last Sunday I mentioned that we should begin to use the term "Crossroads Collaborative" because that is closer to what we are doing. We feel that the Spirit is doing something more here: there is a spark for something new, different, and unknown. A way of doing church that we are living into. Yes, that continues in some traditional ways: Circles, Bible Studies, Committees, Councils, Choirs, Sunday School, Youth Group, Confirmation--and in new ways: Connection Groups, Faith & a Pint, Summer Mid-Week Worship, and even Bingo.

The one I'm most excited about is the relocation of Cristo Rey Lutheran to Atonement, where they will begin their weekly worship service at noon on April 28th. By the time you read this, the worship and celebration will have taken place, Assistant to the Bishop Justin Grimm will have said a blessing over Pastora Ana Becerra and Cristo Rey, and we at Crossroads will be beginning a new chapter in our ministry together.

Would I have ever imagined this five years ago, when I began my ministry among you? No. And that is as it should be. You see: our work together *is not about us but about the living God*. Thanks be to God for that.



Commercial Insurance Policy - CM Select (Brad)

Motion to have Brad pursue the new insurance policy pending no penalty for canceling the

existing policy. If penalty, then switch time of renewal in June 2024 from Gretchen. Paula seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

CHANGES: \$2500 deductible to 1% wind and hail deductible (1% of the coverage amount = \$30,000 deductible) all other damage deductible would be \$5000. Current building structure coverage is \$4.5 million, new policy would be \$3 million. Cuts the premium from \$12k to \$6k. Only the shingled roof is vulnerable to hail.

Jumbo Sale

Jeanette will apply for Thrivent Action Team Grant to support the Jumbo Sale Baptismal Font was built by a founding member. There is a little red book in the office that might have the name of who donated. Would like to install a plaque naming the donor. Florence has suggested and, as one of the most tenured members, given permission to sell the silver items in the display case near Brad's office for cash.

Carpet cleaning

Paula has quotes from Zerorez and David Kahle. Zerorez quote (\$2340) is \$100 less than David's. Time estimate is 6 hours to clean all carpets and pew cushions, minus quilters room and New Birth classroom.

Motion for Paula to move forward from Peg seconded Kolleen; Paula: add classrooms back in; schedule for August after jumbo sale, ask if the price will hold until late summer, ask Zerorez for building space measurement numbers (so Matt and Kevin don't have to re-measure!) Motion Carried unanimously
