Dear Siblings in Christ,

It is SUMMER! Well, meteorological summer at least. Summer breaks from school are here for some--and coming soon for others. Around this time each year I say a prayer for church workers and volunteers as well, as often summer is even busier than the rest of the year, as it brings additional planning especially for youth activities.

This summer at Crossroads, we have **Crossroads' Summer Camp Smash for preschoolers** at King's Kids Preschool, campers going to Wapo and Ox Lake, **Summer Stretch for 6th—12th graders** (August 6th-8th) , and **Vacation Bible School for preschool—5th grade** at Abiding Savior (August 5th—9th).

The summer months also bring annual traditions. We will have **S'more Worship** around the campfire on Tuesday, June 25th; Wednesday, July 24th, and Wednesday, August 7th. **Lutheran Night at the Twins** will take place on August 12th. The **Jumbo Sale** at Cross of Glory will take place on August 8th (9am—7pm), 9th (9am—5pm), and 10th (9am—noon). Make sure to bring your donations for the Jumbo Sale to Cross of Glory on Connection evenings: Tuesdays June 18th—July 30th from 5:30pm—7:30pm.

The goodness that the **Connection Groups** showed us throughout Lent continues: the weekly **Monday morning Bible Study at 8am** at Atonement continues, as does the **Bible Junk Journaling on Thursdays at 4:30pm**. For summer, we are getting some short-term Connection Groups going, including a food truck meet-up and a stroll in the park group. Watch the weekly announcements to see dates and times. If you're interested in starting or leading a connection group, contact the church office. Speaking of connection, outside of church, some students (and adults and staff...) have special events in the summer to invite you to: county fairs, plays, soccer matches, baseball games, concerts, and such. If you have an event you'd like to invite others to attend, list it on the bulletin board sign up in either narthex.

From Cross of Glory Council President

What does God have planned for Cross of Glory? The plan... trust me.

It's an age-old struggle as human beings to want to know everything, to plan for everything, even to anticipate every aspect of our life so that we are not surprised... so that everything works according to plan. But then there are those times, where even biblically God has said, "Let me take care of this, have faith."

Over the last 20+ years of being a member of Cross of Glory we have seen this time and time again. Things will get rough, and then resolve, then get rough again, and then resolve again making us stronger and providing us with opportunities that we would not have normally planned for. So, while some tend to focus on the budget and worry about what the future holds financially, I'd like to take a moment to flip this optic and show legitimately how God has worked through us to make an impact and to provide where needed. Do we need to make smart financial decisions... absolutely. Do we need to over-concern ourselves to the point that it gets in the way of our mission... absolutely NOT.

Over the course of the last year, we have made significant improvements to our property, thanks to the generosity of a donation specifically earmarked for property improvements. This donation allows us to offset expenses to enhance and maintain our property that would normally come from our general fund.

We continue to be blessed with partnerships that increase the usage of our building and support our greater mission of *"Connecting people to Jesus Christ and to each other"* and our newly approved welcoming statement reinforcing that all are welcome here. Some of these partnerships include ministry partners that rent our space, such as New Birth Seventh Day Adventist Family Worship Center who have been with us for quite a while and also the Filipino-American Christian Church who is new to our space. We also host various scouting troops and provide space for recitals and other events. We are truly blessed to be able to provide space for this.

We were able to welcome our new ministry partner Cristo Rey into our Crossroads Parish this year. While Cristo Rey primarily holds their services at Atonement, their impact on our parish can be felt across both the Atonement and Cross of Glory churches and we are so happy to have them as part of the Crossroads Parish!

When COVID forced a shutdown of normal operations, we quickly pivoted to an online presence to ensure that our members and community were still able to feel connected with our worship and connected to our church. In the last year, we have had over 1,600 views of our live streams from not just members of our local community but from people across our country. For some, this is their only connection back to our church, for others, it's a way to stay connected while traveling, working, or maybe even feeling under the weather.

Which brings me to the next piece of recognizing what God has provided. We have a building. And not just any building, but one that is utilized in many ways and more than just for our services. As such, it's our duty to ensure that we are using the building in the most efficient ways possible. Over the next several months, you may see some changes to how rooms are used, and it may seem different than the plan that has been in place for the last 20+ years... and that's OK. I'll say that again... IT'S ALL OK. Care is being taken to thoughtfully plan out these changes, to make our building hospitable and welcoming to all who enter our church. Whether they are coming to worship, or be part of community events. It is our duty to be welcoming and our building should reflect that. More on this to come in the following weeks.

In closing, God has a plan. We may not know the plan, but there is definitely a plan. And sometimes a little faith goes a long way. As we move into the summer, may we keep the faith - our story isn't even close to being done yet.

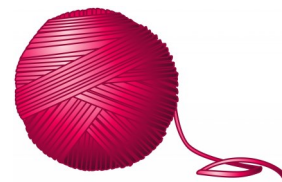


Prayer Shawls Plus

A donor has offered to fund the purchase and installation of two projectors, mounted on the wall or ceiling. Installation should be made such that the hardware is multi-user friendly and can be used by other organizations that use our space.
