Dear Siblings in Christ,

It is the beginning of a new school year--and a return to our fall schedule, which means Sunday worship at 8:30am at Cross of Glory, 10:45am at Atonement, and 12:00pm Cristo Rey worship at Atonement in Spanish beginning Sunday, September 8th. While for many of us it feels good to get back into a good rhythm of the "regular" schedule, for your staff, we will miss the many opportunities we had this summer to be together in one community, gathered to worship and share in fellowship. Seeing all of you getting to know one another and working together toward a common goal: sharing the good news of Jesus.



Keeping this goal in mind, as we return to fall this year, we have a theme: "One in Christ" based on the scripture from the third chapter of Paul's letter to the Galatians: "There is neither Jew nor Greek; there is neither slave nor free; nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. Now if you belong to Christ, then indeed you are Abraham's descendants, heirs according to the promise." (Galatians 3:28-29) It stands out that we are all one in Christ Jesus. This year, we will seek to celebrate being one in Christ, three congregations working together to show all God's love.

On **Sunday, September 8th at God's Work, Our Hands Sunday**, we will complete service projects, making fleece animals at Cross of Glory, tending to the rain garden at Atonement, and participating in a Food Drive. Keeping in mind Assistant to the Bishop Pastor Justin Grimm's words from his sermon to us in August, we will also have an opportunity to reflect on God's Work, Our Voice as a part of the sermon. On **Sunday, September 15th Homecoming Sunday** we will learn about our theme for the year and what it means for our work together. Keeping in this spirit, at the end of the month, in honor of the Vikings/Packer game, we are invited to wear our favorite football (or soccer!) jerseys to worship and following each service, we will take a picture of our congregations. We may follow different sports teams--and we still follow Jesus. :) Let us celebrate that we are indeed one in Christ!

# Helpful Reminders

## Helpful reminders about how to help things go smoothly at Crossroads:

Over the last few years, we've learned a lot about how to be a parish. When multiple churches are being served by one pastor and one very part-time deacon, it's important that we work together to make things easier and more efficient. We are one in Christ--and sometimes that takes a lot of work communicating and figuring things out. We need your help to make things go well:

- 1) Don't put off communicating with Pastor Cassie or Deacon Brad until Sunday. If you have a question or request, reach out directly when it comes up during the week. On Sunday mornings, both Cassie and Brad are often teaching Confirmation classes or have places to be right before or after worship (depending on the site). They also tend to talk to dozens of people each week--and details can get lost in the shuffle. Contacting staff by email or by calling the church office is always best.
- 2) Have a question? Contact the church office at either site. Dawn Saros-Kirk is in the office at Atonement from 8am-noon and Cross of Glory 1pm-5pm most weekdays. You are welcome to call her at either site about details for either congregation. Often, Dawn knows more about what is happening than any of the volunteers or clergy, so trying the office first is a good plan!
- 3) Even though many events are "out of sight, out of mind," for you, that does not mean they are that way for staff and key volunteers. Did you know that each month, the Joint Council, Atonement Council, Cross of Glory Council, Worship Committee, King's Kids Preschool Board, and Property Committee meet? In addition, each Sunday, there are 7 worship services within the walls of our 2 buildings. There's a team of over 20 leaders besides your staff that gather regularly to carry out this work. Much of the time, it makes sense to reach out directly to the committee if you have a question about something. Not sure who to contact? We can help! Call the church office and we will steer you in the right direction!

Thank you for your help in carrying out the ministry of Jesus in our community!

Sunday, September 8 is our ELCA "God's work. Our hands." Service Day at Crossroads. Every Meal, is a non-profit organization that helps fight child hunger by focusing on filling the food gaps children face, especially on the weekends, when they're not able to eat school meals. Through their multiple food gap programs, they provide

children and families experiencing food insecurity with access to good food.

Crossroads will collect non-perishable food items to be donated to Every Meal such as:

• Fruit: Pineapple, peaches, mango, pears, applesauce, mandarin oranges, prunes/raisons

Vegetable: Carrots, corn, mixed veggies, green beans, peas, bamboo shoots, baby corn

• Entrée: Chili, chicken noodle soup, pasta sauce, mac and cheese, ravioli, enchilada sauce, chipotle in adobo, diced chiles, diced tomatoes, tomato paste, fava beans, curry soup, coconut milk, curry paste, tomato soup

• Base/Grain: Rice, spaghetti, macaroni, oatmeal, corn flour, fideo noodles, rice noodles, bean thread

Protein: Tuna, chicken, black beans

Snacks: Individually packaged and NUT-FREE

Please check the expirations dates as expired food cannot be accepted. There will be a collection area in the narthex of both churches for food donations.

<u>Cross of Glory will make simple, fleece rabbits to donate to the Minneapolis Children's Hospital</u>. They are very easy and instructions will be available after service.

Atonement will also work on their rain garden, cleaning and weeding it out so it functions as it should and looks nice for the community.

Review of minutes and to-do's from last meeting. Claire motions to waive reading minutes and approve. Peg seconded. Motion carried unanimously

### Financial Report

No activity has happened in the Wells Fargo investment account, Jon will work with Jill to keep the account "active" and will add Jon and Paula as authorized people on the account. Money will stay where it is for now, Jon will look at options regarding where the best place is for the dollars.

Generous donation account - we are spending from this account for property improvements slowly and carefully. Wapo will be paid 7/18.

### Team Reports—Active Teams

Property (Kevin) - Recycling bins have been ordered (funded by a grant)

Worship & Music (Paula) - Worship committee has planned out through the end of January 2025.

Marketing/Communications (Matt) - Website updates; facebook content; Cristo Rey has been adding their own to the website too. Fixed ability to see past weeks' worship details. Working on a youth page on the website. Request from Paula - can we set-up an electronic signup sheet (ie Sign-up Genius or REMIND) to get schedules and sign-ups out to youth and parents. Paula to send Matt an email with volunteer opportunities, dates and times; including a DUE DATE.

Outreach (Brad/Peg) - Ministry Partner Updates (Rentals/Space users, etc.) - Matt will be sending a monthly communication to all the groups/congregations that use the church regarding any information, issues, and feedback that needs to be shared. Both rental congregations are receptive to the feedback and how to make this arrangement work. A cleanup checklist has been created and shared and well received. Paula to send Matt an item for the monthly communication that we will be opening up the fellowship hall a week earlier than expected in preparation for the Jumbo Sale

Youth (Claire/Bea) - No update

Financial/Fundraising (Jon/Gretchen) - Jon will give Gretchen access to the data to work on financial visualizations Jumbo Sale Updates (Paula) - Tent rental is more expensive than expected. Tent with sides, 20x40 foot tent on amazon costs less than the rental cost. Could we rent Pods (movable storage units?) Matt will reach out to Scouts to see if anyone has something for us to borrow. Could we rent 2 - 20x20 tents? Gretchen will ask her neighbor about renting theirs (probably 20x20, no sides) (Aug 4 - 11). We are VERY short on storage space this year. We have a lot of donations. More donations at Atonement need to be picked up and delivered to Cross of Glory. Gretchen's mother-in-law will help sell fabric for us.



# Cross of Glory Sanctuary Refresh




This mass of cords and tables will be gone. The sliding doors can be used again which is helpful with multiple users of the sanctuary.





A new AV booth is being built for all the equipment & better sound for the techs. A new system is being purchased so a projector isn't needed. We'll have 2 large screen TVs that will be easier to read what's displayed. Eventually all the cords will be tucked away resulting in a cleaner look.
